FIREFIGHTER MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- U.S. citizenship & valid IL driver's license
- DD214 (if applicable)
- No felony or disqualifying misdemeanor convictions (70 ILCS 705/16.06)
- High school diploma or equivalent
- 21 to 35 years of age by date of hire unless otherwise exempt by statute (70 ILCS 705/16.06b (c))
- BOF preferred, but will send to academy if EMT-P
- IDPH Paramedic License (must pass the National paramedic exam within 90 days of hire).
- CPAT and Ladder Climb verification (by time of hire)
- Completed personal history questionnaire (PHQ) through NTN

TRANSFER OPTION:

Candidates who currently serve as a Sworn, Full-time firefighter/paramedic in a municipal fire department or fire protection district are eligible for a starting salary up to \$100,130 (Step 4 + EMT-P stipend) and up to 9 vacation days commensurate to years of experience.

BENEFITS:

- ♦ Starting Salary Range: \$80,358—\$109,865 (includes EMT-P Stipend)
- ♦ CBA outlines additional pay for certifications, degrees and longevity schedules
- ♦ Health, dental, vision and life insurance per CBA
- ♦ Kelly Days, vacation time, sick time accrual, PEHP/VEBA contribution, holidays paid out as a bonus in December plus pay for holidays worked
- ♦ Members in the West Suburban Fire Rescue Alliance; shared SOG's with 8 neighboring departments operationally work as one large department, excellent training!
